



(As an example of the "parenting" some of our moms receive - one of our moms was told by her father not to bother calling him to pick her up from a meeting until after 9:00 because he would be watching "Big Brother" and didn't want to be interrupted! She's just 16 years old, and had her 3 month old daughter with her!)

We have one computer tutor - and would LOVE to have more! If you know ANYTHING about computers - even if it's "just" typing - we could use your help!

We've had a few inquiries from supporters who have switched their long distance phone services to LifeLine. They had received information from a competitor that led them to believe that LifeLine may not have been giving us 10% of their long distance charges, and that LifeLine had recently signed a contract with MCI (which has connections to pornography and supports the homosexual agenda).

We called LifeLine to try to clear this up, and this is what they had to say - a "disgruntled employee left LifeLine, taking their mailing list with him, and has been contacting people on the list with misleading information." LifeLine is in litigation with this person, and wants to assure everyone who is using their services that they have been misrepresented.
